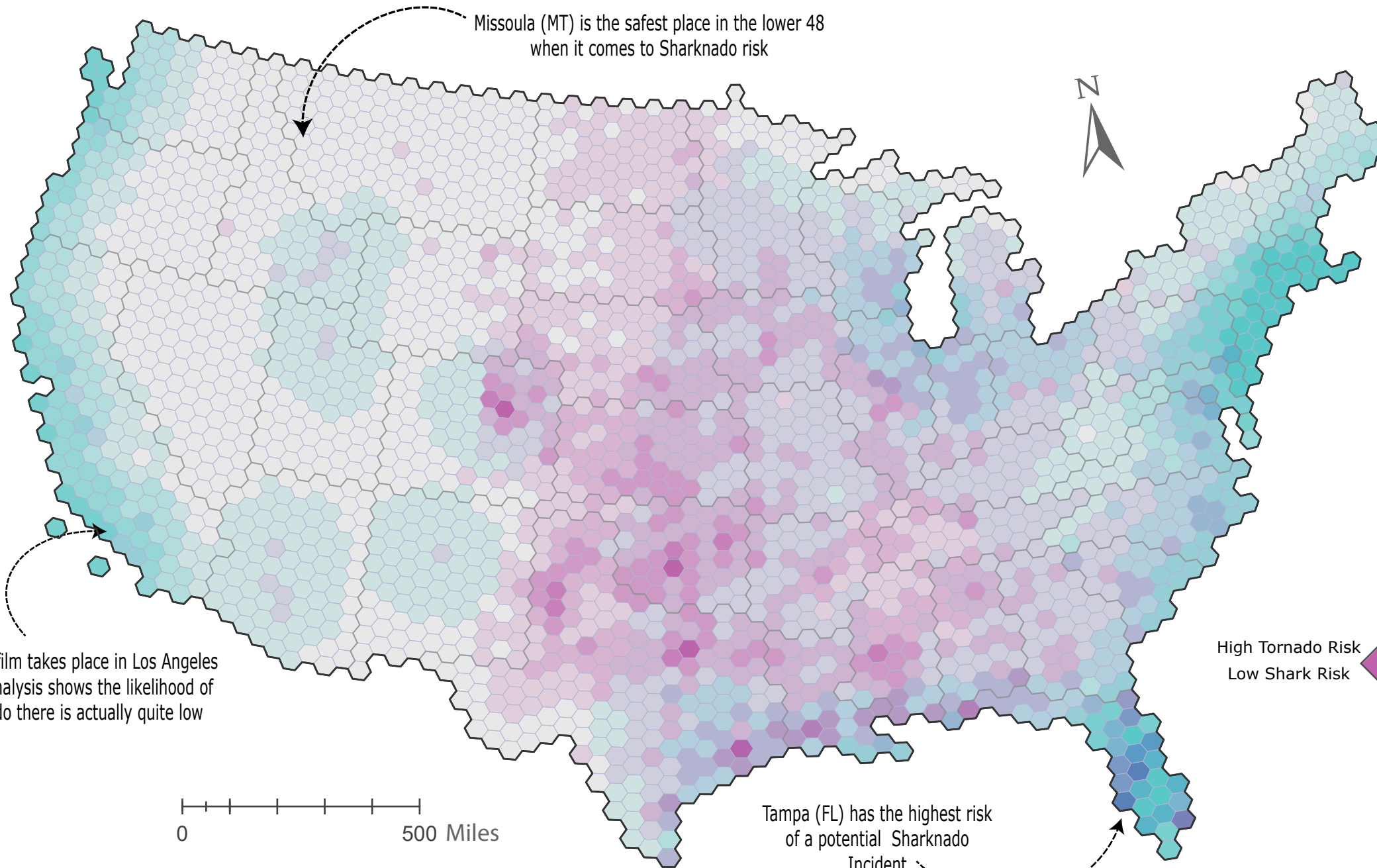
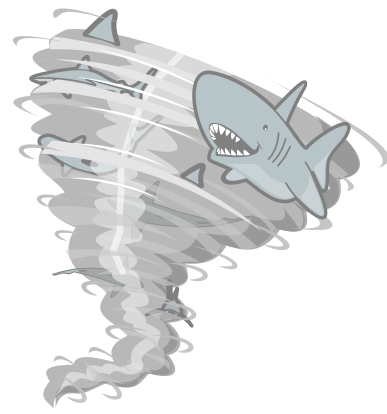
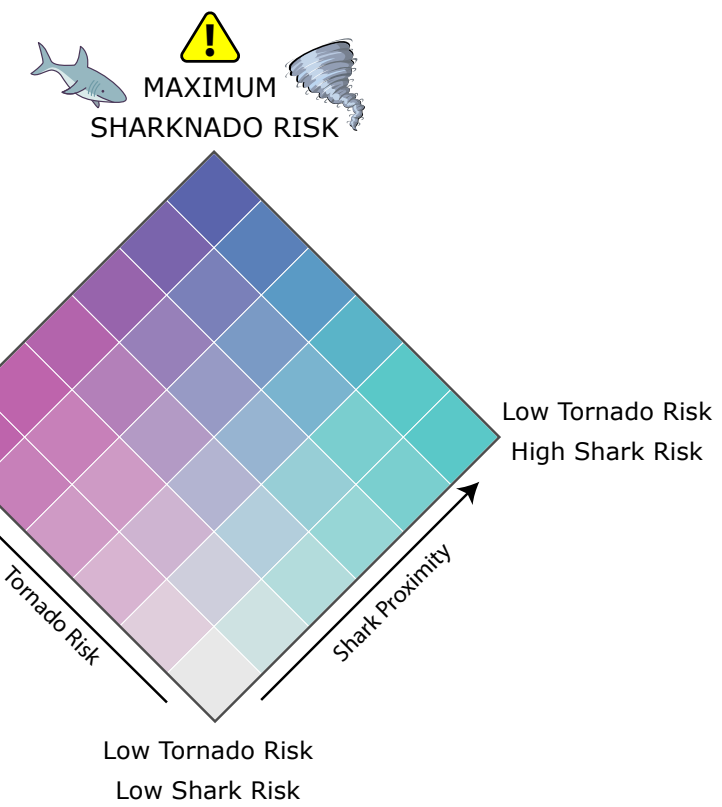


# SHARKNADO USA: SHOULD YOU BE WORRIED?
